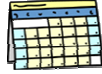


# Daily Skills Review

## Date & Time

Q: How many days are there in the week?  
A: There are seven days in the week.



Q: Name the days of the week.  
A: Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday

\*Use Days of the Week Chart for reinforcement/learning. Point to and say each day, child repeats or does on own. Extra: What is your favorite day? Why?

Q: Today is \_\_\_\_\_. What was yesterday?  
What is tomorrow?  
A: Name the name of the day, and yesterday and tomorrow.

Q: How many months are there in the year?  
A: There are 12 months in the year.

Q: Name the months of the year.  
A: January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December.

Use Months of the Year Chart for reinforcement/learning. Extra: What is your favorite month?

Q: What is the name of the first month? Last month? "xth" month.  
A: January, December, etc.

Q: What is a year?  
A: The time it takes for the earth to go (orbit) around the sun.

Q: How many days are there in a year?  
A: There are 365 days in a year.

Extra: What year were you born? What year is this?

Q: What is a day?  
A: The time it takes for the earth to turn around (revolve) one time.

Q: How many hours are there in a day?  
A: There are 24 hours in a day.

Q: When do you eat breakfast? (morning)  
Q: When do you eat lunch/pray thuhr? (afternoon)  
Q: When do you eat dinner? (evening)  
Q: When do you.....?

Extra: What is your favorite time of the day?

Q: What is today's date?  
A: Today is (name of day, month, day, year)  
Q: What was yesterday's date? What is tomorrow's date?  
What will the date be in "x" days? What date was it "x" days ago?

Q: On what date were you born?

Q: What time is it?



Q: What time will it be in "x" hours/minutes? What time was it "x" minutes/hours ago.

Q: What time do you: wake up? Go to bed? Eat lunch? Eat dinner? Pray maghrib/thuhr/asr/fajr/isha?

Say and show on demonstration clock

Q: What prayer do we pray we get up?  
Q: What is the last prayer of the day called?  
Q: What prayer do we pray at noon/lunch time?  
Q: What prayer do we pray when the sun sets?  
Q: What prayer do we pray in the late afternoon?

Q: How many seasons are there?  
A: There are four seasons.

Q: Name the four seasons.  
A: Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer.

Q: Which season is cold? Hot? In which season do the leaves fall from the trees? In which season do the leaves and flowers start to grow back?

### AFTER REVIEW PERIOD INDEPENDENT ACTIVITIES:

Students can work on these by themselves sometime after the review period:

- Activities/Cards
- Writing Practice:

Daily:

Write your name (1-5x)  
Write/trace the name of the day-5x (Sunday, etc )  
Write today's date, 1-5x  
Write the name of the current season (1 - 5x)

Weekly:

Write all the names of the seasons  
Write the names of the months  
Write the names of the days of the week  
Write the words "morning, afternoon, night"  
Write the names of the Salat



Tips:

- Review these concepts daily in a brief sitting. These are also great for those days when you don't have anything planned.
- This review spans preschool to approximately second grade. Start off with just a few items for preschool and gradually add on as they master concepts or show interest in others.
- You can use the learning charts or a calendar bulletin board display to learn/practice concepts with the questions.
- Keep the skill sheets and learning charts in page protectors in one binder for easy access.
